What is required to do your admission?

- Holders of the NCC Level 3 Diploma in Business (L3DB) (RQF), the NCC Education Level 3 Diploma in Computing (L3DC) (RQF) or the Level 3 International Foundation Diploma for Higher Education Studies (L3IFDHES) qualifications or any local or international qualification deemed to be similar and accepted by NCC Education;
- Holder of one "A" level or equivalent or an appropriate School Leaver's Certificates;
- Mature students that can be able to demonstrate over 2 years' relevant work experience and with "O" level/ GCSE English and Maths or equivalent;
- For students whose first language is not English, they have to be holders of IELTS 5.5 or equivalent.
